



## Granite Patios and Steps

Rainford, Lancashire

## Case Study

Extensive new granite paved patios and terraces were created around this substantial new property in Rainford as a feature to enhance the overall landscaping and design. This included additional stone faced walls and steps to accommodate the different existing ground levels on the sloping site, and all of these works was undertaken and completed by the specialist Natural Stone Contractor, PDG Groundworks.

The paved surfaces were produced with the owners choice of 'Magma' coloured, saw-cut granite slabs from a standard width of 450 mm and a thickness of 50 mm for optimum durability; the outer edges of each area were highlighted with strip of tumbled granite setts in the same 'Magma' colour. Contrasting red sandstone cladding was used for the walls.

**GftK's vdw 850 Paving Joint Mortar** from **NCC Streetscape Limited** was selected by PDG for all of the joint pointing and grouting works, as from experience, they knew that this was the best solution to providing the high performance and durability required. The **vdw 850** is a high performance, epoxy resin bound paving joint material, which applied as a 'wet-slurry' that then self-compacts into the joints to give a non-staining and highly durable finish, designed to last for many years to come.
