## Case Study

This is a paved courtyard garden in Bracknell, where the owner wanted the whole area paved to falls, using random sized, cut Black Limestone slabs. With this strong black colour the owner also required that the jointing was to be made in a light colour shade, to produce an attractive pattern and design that adds to the overall aesthetics of the garden.

They were also concerned that the jointing mortar be non-staining so that it did not dull down the natural stone surfaces, such as cement based materials frequently do, which then requires extensive and repeated cleaning and washing to achieve complete removal from the surface.

The hard landscaping specialists from Buds used vdw 800 Jointing Mortar in a contrasting sand beige colour from NCC Streetscape, to joint and point all of this paving as it met all of the owners requirements.

The vdw 800 Jointing Mortar has a very uniform and stable colour, it is non-staining and contains no cement as it is based on water dispersed epoxy resin bound, finely graded aggregates.

Additionally to assist the landscaper, this material is installed by fast slurry application, even in wet weather, and then it quickly hardens to give a durable long-term paved surface.
