## Case Study

At this house in Hartley Witney, the owners wanted a new block paving driveway, but with higher quality natural stone paving around the front entrance area to create a feature pathway. In discussion with the paving specialists from Buds Landscapes, a design using random sized, Brown Indian Sandstone slabs was agreed.

In areas these slabs also had to be cut on site and installed around manholes and other details, which were required to be finished to the highest standards, with accurate, fully 'squared' positioning. Additionally, all of the natural stonework areas had to be installed and opened as fast as possible because they were the main pedestrian entrance area to the property.

To meet all of these requirements, particularly the tight timing, Buds used vdw 800 Jointing Mortar from NCC Streetscape. This unique paving jointing and pointing mortar was quickly applied and allowed pedestrian access within just 24 hours.

The vdw 800 Jointing Mortar also ensured that the necessary precise detailing could be achieved and provides an extremely tough and durable paved surface, fully resistant to weed growth and attack by boring insects.
