Garden Pathways, Guildford, Surrey

Case Study

The pathway and patio in this open and exposed garden area, which is on the outskirts of Guildford, had to be laid and completed during a period of protracted wet weather.

The owners had decided on a creative design from Buds Landscapes, using random sized, riven, Raj Green Indian Sandstone slabs, with Salmon Pink granite sett borders.

To ensure that the work was not interrupted and delayed during the forecast periods of actual rain or imminent rainfall, for the grouting of the paving Buds selected vdw 800 Pavement Jointing Mortar from NCC Streetscape in a sand beige colour. This advanced paving jointing mortar is based on special epoxy resin bound and graded fine aggregates, which enables it to be applied and cure, even in periods of cold and continuously wet weather.

Additionally, it is fast to install using slurry application techniques and then hardens to provide a tough, durable paved surface, with long-term resistance to weed growth and attack by boring insects.
