Patio and Terrace - Private Residence, Skelmersdale

Case Study

This refurbishment project at a private residence in Skelmersdale, Lancashire, comprised of natural sandstone patios and pathways, plus a once attractive, bespoke designer sandstone circle, complete with granite sett edging, all of which were now looking sad and dirty, with cracked and failing joints throughout. The owners contacted patio refurbishment specialists CR Services who they found on Facebook, and who had completed several similar projects around Manchester. Immediately it was clear that NCC Blackspot & Green Growth Remover, plus GftK's vdw 850+, a non-staining, 2-part epoxy resin based, paving jointing mortar, were the ideal solutions.

The paving was jet-washed, then the old jointing removed and surfaces treated with the NCC Blackspot & Green Growth Remover, to facilitate the removal of unsightly growths and dark staining deposits from the natural stone slabs.

Although it was raining at the time booked for the job, this was no problem using GftK's vdw 850+, as it is applied by wet-slurry techniques, meaning that during application the wetter, the better! The material effectively self-compacts into the joints, without additional tooling, and then hardens, even if the wet weather continues!
