



Sandstone & Porcelain Star Feature Driveway in Durham

Case Study

Durham based, LTC Landscapes, who previously specialised in trees and gardens, recently extended their services to include paving works and provide complete landscaping solutions for their customers. Having read favourable reviews from other contractors on social media and elsewhere, they were keen to try GftK paving jointing mortars; they particularly liked their ease and speed of installation, as well as the extended service life.

The owner of LTC Landscapes had just laid 45m² of new Kandla grey Indian sandstone paving at his own home to create a stylish new driveway, and this included a decorative circle and within that, a feature star formed with hand-cut, contrasting black and white porcelain with astroturf inserts.
