



Patio & Pathways, Nantwich, Cheshire

Case Study

The patio and pathways at this private residence in Nantwich, Cheshire, were 10 years old and badly in need of refurbishment. The original sand and cement jointing was cracked and failing, and the paving slabs were discoloured, with a few slabs debonded. An earlier attempt to repoint the failed joints with more sand and cement had been unsuccessful, and as a result, the paving was unsightly and spoiling an otherwise well maintained garden.

Specialist paving contractor CR Services were contacted and asked to carry out the refurbishment. They first removed the old jointing and reset loose paving slabs, then jet-washed and thoroughly cleaned with NCC Grime Remover, a heavy duty surface cleaner. They then advised using GftK vdw 850+ paving joint mortar from NCC Streetscape as the best solution to replace the cement based pointing.

GftK's vdw 850+ is a tough, high performance, non-staining, 2-part epoxy paving mortar, that effectively self-compacts into the joints, and is applied standing up by wet slurry techniques, making the whole repointing process both quick and efficient.

The paved areas now look as good as new, and in fact are tougher and now able to withstand any future maintenance including frequent jet-washing.
