## Case Study

PDG Groundworks designed this new patio with steps and a garden path using the owner's selection of sawn 'Pink Pearl' natural granite slabs, with 'Kobra Green' granite strips around the outer edge. The 450 mm wide 30 mm thick slabs were bedded on a solid foundation and then **GftK's vdw 850 Paving Joint Mortar** in the complementary 'Basalt' colour was used for all of the joint pointing and grouting works. From experience PDG knew that this was the best solution to preventing weed growth or boring insects damaging the paving and providing the durability required.

**GftK's vdw 850 Paving Joint Mortar** from **NCC Streetscape Limited** is a high performance, epoxy resin bound grout that is applied as a 'wet-slurry' onto pre-wetted surfaces, also removing the risks of cracking and shrinkage that is always a big danger with both traditional and proprietary cement based pointing. It effectively self-compacts into the joints to give a non-staining and highly durable finish, designed to last for many years to come.

As **GftK's vdw 850** is wet-slurry applied on a pre-dampened surface, there is also no need to wait for dry conditions and a dry weather forecast with these materials – the paving pointing can be done on schedule and the projects finished on time.
