



Private Residential Driveway, Cheshire

Case Study

The owner of this newly extended and refurbished detached property in Cheshire, had an existing sound, but tired looking, asphalt driveway and parking areas that looked out of place with the refreshing modern style of the house.

They wanted to turn this into an attractive useable space to enhance rather than detract from the appearance of the property, and with a little online research and references found that NCC Streetscape had the ideal solution. This was to use the Addagrip Stonebound System, which is based on 18mm thick, UV stable resin and selected graded aggregates to provide a permeable, slip and skid resistant, very hard-wearing driveway surface.

Thelwell flooring were selected to carry out all the preparatory and resin application works on this project, as they are a very experienced specialist contractor who are also based in the North West of England, though they work all over the UK due to their technical expertise. After first cleaning and preparing the asphalt surface by vacuum blastcleaning and vacuuming, Thelwell installed over 300m² of the Addagrip Stonebound System in a special colour blend selected by the owners. As a result, the owners are delighted, and they now have this fantastic, highly aesthetic and exceptionally durable driveway, with surfacing that really does enhance the overall appearance (and value) of this distinguished property.
