## Residential Driveway, Crosby Beach, Sefton, Merseyside

## Case Study

The owners of this newly refurbished detached property in Crosby Beach, close to Antony Gormley's famous statues, wanted to turn the gated frontage into an attractive driveway, parking area and other useable hard standing space. They also wanted to have a uniform surface without having needless area limitations that always vary over time for the family and visitors. Obviously in this area it was also important that the finish could enhance and blend in with the traditionally built property.

Following their online research and after checking on other reference projects, they concluded NCC Streetscape had the ideal solution using the Addagrip Stonebound System, which is based on 18mm thick, UV stable resin, to provide a permeable, slip and skid resistant, very hard-wearing driveway and hard landscaping surface.

The system was installed by William Lea, an experienced specialist contractor from Liverpool, in Addagrip's 'Barkwood Blend', which is a specially selected blend of coloured aggregates that the owners felt gave the appearance of a traditional gravel, but without all the disadvantages and maintenance headaches.
