The owners of this detached, prestige property in Crosby Beach, wanted to turn the gated frontage into an attractive driveway, with plenty of parking areas and other useable hard standing space. They also wanted to have a uniform surface without area limitations, as the requirements for family and visitors will inevitably vary over time. It was also important that the selected surfacing would blend-in well and enhance the overall appearance.

Following their research and checking reference projects, they concluded that NCC Streetscape had the ideal solution in the Addagrip Stonebound System. This is an advanced, UV stable, 2-part polyurethane resin bound system, which is installed at 18mm thickness over a prepared substrate to provide a permeable and SUDS compliant, slip and skid resistant, very hard-wearing driveway and hard landscaping surface.

The system was installed by William Lea, an experienced specialist contractor from Liverpool, in Addagrip's 'Barkwood Blend', which is a specially selected blend of coloured aggregates that the owners felt gave the appearance of a traditional gravel, but without all the disadvantages and maintenance headaches. William Lea's site team applied the Stonebound mortar to line and level with lasers and battens, then finished the surface with their high performance powerfloat techniques, which ensure the optimum compaction and aesthetics of the finish, as well as long term durability and looking good for many years.
