



## Private Residential Driveway, Liverpool

### Case Study

To enhance the frontage of this newly extended and refurbish detached property in Liverpool, the owners wanted to have maximum flexibility for use in terms of the frontage, for family and friends to have ample off-street parking as well as driveway access to the integral double garage. They were also concerned about preventing any environmental impact of paved surfaces and wanted to ensure that the surfacing was not only permeable to meet SUDS drainage requirements, but also to help minimise any storm water run-off as a contribution to environmental protection.

They contacted the screed and surfacing specialists William Lea Limited, who are also based in Liverpool, for advice, and they had no hesitation in proposing NCC's Addagrip Stonebound System. This is trowel applied over a highly permeable asphaltic or cementitious base, and is laid as an 18mm thick topping, using a UV stable, 2-part polyurethane resin binder, to provide a permeable, slip and skid resistant, very hard-wearing surfacing system. The Stonebound System is ideal for producing SUDS Compliant driveways, hardstanding, and other surfaces for pedestrian and vehicular traffic.

The William Lea site team applied the Stonebound mortar to line and level with lasers and battens, then finished the surface with their high performance powerfloat techniques, which ensure the optimum compaction and aesthetics of the finish, as well as long term durability for the client – Another great Stonebound job!
