Sawn Sandstone Patio, Warrington, Cheshire

Case Study

The sawn sandsone paving slabs used to build this patio at a private residence in Warrington, enabled it to be constructed incorporating narrow 4mm joints, giving this natural stone patio a beautiful, clean appearance. Unfortunately, the single pack, 'standard' paving compound that was chosen for the pointing failed within the first 12 months.

CR Services were contacted, and together with their specialist material supplier NCC Streetscape, decided that GftK vdw 815+, an advanced, 2-part epoxy paving mortar was the ideal solution for this project. It is stain free and is specifically designed to fill narrow joints completely, thus avoiding any voids forming, which would threaten the structural integrity of the joints and lead to the joints failing. GftK's vdw 815+ is applied by wet slurry techniques from a standing position, making the process fast and efficient, and it can be applied in wet and cold conditions, meaning no delays because of the weather.

Prior to grouting, the team from CR Servces removed the failing grout and the patio slabs were jet-washed and thoroughly cleaned using NCC Black Spot & Green Growth Remover, which removes unsightly green staining and hard to remove lichen deposits.

The end result is a beautiful patio that is now tough and durable, can withstand frost and jetwashing and will last for many years into the future.
