



Cobbled Driveway, Wilmslow, Cheshire

Case Study

This large cobbled driveway and courtyard, at this residence in Wilmslow, covers an area of 125m², and is subjected to heavy domestic usage as it is driven over daily by the family's three cars. Although the natural sandstone setts were still in good condition, the original cement based pointing was not up to the task with this constant exposure and was cracking and failing.

Following online research, the owners contacted CR Services, who, together with their specialist material suppliers, NCC Streetscape, decided that GftK vdw 850+, an advanced, stain free, 2-part epoxy paving mortar was the ideal solution for this project. It is tough and durable and can easily handle the stress and loadings of vehicle movements.

CR Services removed the failing cement grout and replaced it with vdw 850+, which is applied using wet slurry techniques in a comfortable standing position, effectively self compacting into the joints with no additional tooling, making the whole operation both quick and clean. A major advantage of vdw 850+ is that it can be applied in the wet and cold, so no waiting around for the weather - a huge plus in the UK!

The homeowner was delighted with their choice of GftK's vdw 850+, as his courtyard and driveway not only look magnificent again but they are now up to the job and will be for many years to come.
