Patio and Pathways, West Byfleet, Surrey

Case Study

The owner of this house in West Byfleet wanted new patios and pathways and had selected random sized, riven, Brown Indian Sandstone slabs with brick edging. Buds Landscapes were instructed to create the paved areas and to complete them as soon as possible, to allow the owners to use the areas for barbeques and dining 'al-fresco'.

Unfortunately, despite the work being scheduled for early summer time, the British weather was non-cooperative and the next weeks forecast was also for continuing cold and wet conditions. These can cause serious delays and problems with all types of cement based or polymeric jointing materials such as washing out of the freshly applied mortar, shrinkage and cracking, plus extended waiting time before opening the area for use, with the risk of additional cleaning requirements or surface staining.

Buds avoided all of these problems by using vdw 800 Paving Jointing Mortar from NCC Streetscape; this is based on epoxy resin bound graded aggregates. This advanced paving jointing mortar can be applied in cold and wet weather, even in the rain and without any such issues, which helped to ensure that Buds could complete all of the works on schedule and the areas were ready to use as soon as the weather allowed.
