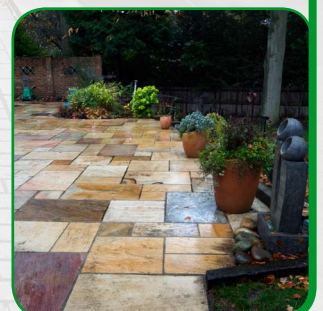
Case Study

The large terraces and footpaths around this house in Cobham totalled more than 300 square metres and were created by Buds Landscapes using random sized, riven Fossil Mint Indian Sandstone slabs. They were designed and installed to be visually attractive and stimulating from all aspects, and they had to be at strictly uniform levels and falls, completely stable for disabled access.

Additionally they were also required to be fully resistant against weed growth and attack by boring insects, so as to ensure long-term durability of the paving with minimal maintenance requirements. The paving specialists from Buds knew that the best way to meet all of these requirements was to use the high performance vdw 800 Jointing Mortar produced in Germany by GftK and supplied exclusively in the UK by NCC Streetscape Limited.

This advanced pavement jointing material also has advantages in its speed of application and curing, plus it is non-staining, even on many sensitive natural stone surfaces – such as light coloured riven Indian Sandstone. The vdw 800 Jointing Mortar is ‘squeegeed’ across the surface to fill the joints, then the area is rinsed off with a little clean water and finally brushed off when dry.
