



Newark Market Square Newark, Nottinghamshire

Case Study

The medieval market square in Newark still has open air markets and activities being held for 6 days a week, which means all different types of delivery vehicles and traffic and requires frequent machine cleaning. Since 1999 the District Council has been undertaking an improvement programme with 100mm Porphyry stone setts.

The pointing of the joints has been an ongoing concern and all types of mortars have been used but unsuccessfully. Finally the Council identified **GftK** mortars from **NCC Streetscape** to overcome all of the problems and so A C Moore Construction Ltd used the **GftK** mortar to grout the newly laid area of porphyry setts. This also enabled this area to be grouted up within one day, as against several days with conventional materials.
